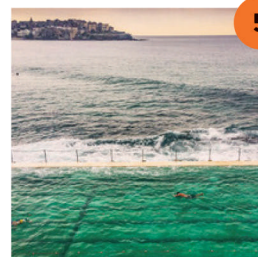
2 Fettle Amy Haarhoff

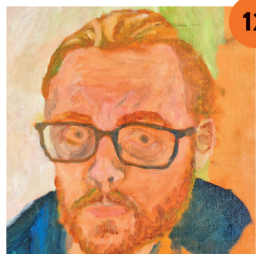

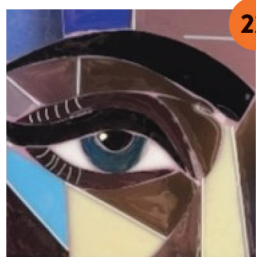
